YMCA ACHIEVEMENT PLUS GUIDELINES

(Please keep this page)

- Once you have applied for a tutor, you are put on a waiting list. When a tutor has been found that matches your needs, the Tutoring Coordinator will phone you and let you know when tutoring will begin.
- Come prepared. Bring all of your books and assignments to each tutoring session. Do your homework in advance so your tutor can help you with the things you are having problems understanding.
- If you are in any way unhappy or uncomfortable with the tutoring you are receiving, please tell the Tutoring Coordinator, whom either can help solve the problems or match you with a different tutor.
- If you feel you no longer want or need tutoring, please let the Tutoring Coordinator know as soon as possible.
- Tutoring sessions begin with one initial meeting with yourself, your tutor and the Tutoring Coordinator to organize what sort of help is needed and to review the tutoring guidelines.

Special Notes:

- There is no tutoring on school holidays.
- There is tutoring on days when there is early dismissal.
- All tutoring sessions take place at the YMCA.
- We are able to provide this program free of charge to participants because of the generosity of our tutors who volunteer their time. However, donations toward the program's operating costs are encouraged from those who can afford it. All contributions are tax deductible and can be made at the front desk of the YMCA.
